## **Welcome to Queanbeyan District Dog Training Club**

### **For Our Beginners:**

Please come to the club grounds on Hoover Road on the first Sunday of your enrolment term (5/2/2023), in time for an 8.30am (term 1 & 4) and 9.00am (term 2 & 3) introduction lecture.

Please arrive 10 minutes early to register your attendance between the shipping containers at the far end of the car park.

Your first day, is your introduction to the club, training lecture and demonstration.

**PLEASE DO NOT bring your dogs on this day as you won't be training this day.**

**For Week 2 of your classes start at 8.30am (term 1 & 4) and 9.00am (term 2 & 3)**

Please arrive 10 minutes early to be put into your classes (meeting at the same place you did your introduction lecture).

You will be introduced to your instructors and placed in classes and have your first lesson. Don't forget to bring treats for your puppy!

**Weeks 3 to week 8, your classes start at 8.30am (term 1 & 4) and 9.00am (term 2 & 3)**

When you and your dog arrive at club, please wait in the parking area for your instructor to take you out to your class. Don't forget treats to train your puppy!

**The final week of classes is assessment day. 2 April 2023**

On assessment day, please arrive with plenty of time to: **Time TBA** - keep an eye on the facebook page & website notice board.

1. Leave your pup in the car, come to the registration desk, and register for assessment.
2. Tell the club team member, at the registration desk, that you are assessing for Beginners.
3. The team member will tell you which ring you are in.
4. Collect your pup and wait to be called to your ring – follow your assessor out to the ring for assessment.

**PLEASE – DO NOT walk on the rings**, walk around the rings to get to your ring.

The rings will be marked with red cones and yellow cone start markers.

If you pass your assessment you will go up to the next class in the next term – you **DO NOT** need to enrol again, as your fees are paid up for the financial year.

Going up to intermediate: your classes will start at 9:30 (terms 1 & 4) or 10:00am (terms 2 & 3) each Sunday and you bring your dog on the first day of each term from now on.
