





Meet the Instructor: Karen Jenkins

Karen is our current president and can be found out on the grounds on Sunday mornings instructing a variety of our classes, as well as training her own dog Charlie in Novice.

How long have you been training your dog(s)?

When we moved to Canberra in the beginning of 2009 and we decided this is where we were going to stay, the family made the decision on getting 2 dogs. We picked up Charlie (aged 2) in late 2009 and Benji (aged 4-5) just after that.

Charlie was a handful around other dogs, although he lives with Benji and gets along fine. Prior to Charlie living with us, he had developed a learned behaviour of being the aggressor around other dogs, so I decided to seek out training. This started my journey of dog training. My daughter and I trained both dogs to Community Companion Dog (CCD) level, and I still work Charlie in Companion Dog (CD). Charlie still is not a fan of other dogs, but he is now willing to share the space around him without too many incidents

What do you like most about training your dog(s)?

Training for me means playing with my dogs... and having fun learning new things. I like teaching new things and watching them develop through the process.

What has been the best bit of advice you've received about dog training and why?

Being careful about what you reinforce. It wasn't until it was pointed out to me, that I started to see unwanted behaviours being reinforced by the humans all the time. We do it without thinking sometimes.

The other thing that I practice is consistency. Don't just so the training at the club, do it everywhere as part of your every day.

Why did you decide to be an instructor?

I had been at the club for a couple of years, and was approach to become an instructor. After doing the Club instructor course, I enrolled myself in a Cert III of Dog training and Behaviour. I really enjoy learning about dogs and trying to understanding there mindset.

What is your biggest challenge as an instructor?

Winter... I am not a fan of the cold, and neither is Charlie.

That and finding the balance of talking verses instructing and practicing. There is so much information out there that I like to share.

How do you spend your time with your dog (s) when it's not Sunday morning?

Chilling with them at home. Playing different games. Walking them around the neighbourhood. I think I know more about the walking tracks now because of them.

SUMMARY OF THE DUTIES OF QDDTC COMMITTEE POSITIONS

President:

Is the chief executive of the Club and presides at all General and Committee meetings, whenever possible, and represents the Club at all official functions.

Vice-President:

In the absence of the President, is to carry out all the roles and responsibilities applicable to the President.

Secretary:

Is to exercise and perform all the usual secretarial functions and generally attend to the secretarial work of the club and in particular shall be responsible for:

- (a) Collecting, registering and distributing all incoming and outgoing correspondence;
- (b) Taking minutes of all proceedings of meetings of the Committee and of the Club;
- (c) Maintaining and retaining all the necessary records of the affairs of the Club;
- (d) Keeping a complete record of all awards and honours made at all exhibitions and shows conducted by the Club; and
- (e) Promulgating all notices of meetings to members.

Treasurer:

Is responsible for all financial transactions entered into on behalf of the Club and shall be responsible for:

- (a) Receiving and receipting all monies paid to the Club and cause the same to be paid into the banking account of the Club kept for such purpose within fourteen days of the receipt thereof;
- (b) Keeping all necessary books of account and financial statements as shall be required by the Auditors;
- (c) Preparing the Annual Balance Sheet and Accounts and accompanying reports;
- (d) Submitting financial statements to all meetings of the Committee and of the Club;
- (e) Producing to the Members in General Meeting the cash books and Bank pass book when requested so to do;
- (f) Keeping vouchers for payments authorised by the Club and the Committee; and
- (g) Keeping a true and correct inventory of all property of the Club.

Assistant Secretary/Enrolments:

Assist the Secretary in exercising and performing their duties. Maintaining an enrolment list of all financial members.

Committee Members:

Manage and control the affairs of the Club subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution. Some of these functions include:
